## ORDER TERMINATING BURN BAN FOR HARRISON COUNTY

WHEREAS, circumstances and rainfall totals have improved in Harrison County, Texas such as to justify the termination and lifting at this time of the previous adopted ban on outdoor burning as approved by the Harrison County Commissioner's Court on August 7, 2023. Lifting of said burn ban is appropriate after consulting with the Harrison County Fire Marshal who indicates conditions have improved in Harrison County, Texas. Rainfall within the past couple of days has shown beneficial rainfall across the county which indicates that conditions will continue below levels that require a burn ban at the present time.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED that the prior ban on outdoor burning recently adopted by the Harrison County Commissioner's Court is hereby lifted and terminated.
