

## **REQUEST FOR JURY TRIAL SETTING**

The Court is now conducting scheduling conferences. It will no longer be necessary to submit a Request for Setting. If you wish to schedule a case for jury trial, you may contact Leslie Meshell in order to set up a scheduling conference with Judge Brad Morin.

Scheduling conferences are generally held at the time of setting for a certain case. Please confer with opposing counsel prior to requesting a setting. *I.e. if the case is set for a hearing on 2/2/13 at 10:30 a.m. the request for trial can be formally announced and discussed at the hearing.*

At the conclusion of discussing the scheduling conference at the court hearing, it will be the requesting party's responsibility to submit an appropriate Scheduling Order for entry.

You may send an Agreed Scheduling Order if all parties are in agreement, as long as your trial date has been approved prior to submission because, although the lawyers may agree to late November of 2015, the Court may want to set the case earlier, say for 2013 or so. We are trying to avoid over scheduling during any given week.
