1. Exact title as you would like this request to appear on the Agenda:
Review and approval of rates of pay and allocations for the 2017 November 7th Constitutional Amendment Election Temporary Poll Workers and Ballot Board members based on the Early Voting and Consolidated Election Day Polling Locations, Dates and Times that were presented at the August 28, 2017 regular commissioners court meeting.
2. Brief description of the subject to be discussed.
The following proposed rates of pay were presented as part of the Elections budget for FY2017-2018 and are consistent with prior budgets and elections. The only change from prior budgets and elections is the addition of a Poll Worker Training stipend to encourage retention:
 - o Temporary Poll Workers and Ballot Board members - \$8.50 per hour
 - o Early Voting Lead Clerk - \$10.00 one-time fee per location
 - o Election Day Presiding Judge - \$25.00 one-time fee per location
 - o Early Voting Ballot Board (EVBB) Presiding Judge - \$25.00 one-time fee
 - o Central Counting Station Board (CCSB) Presiding Judge - \$25.00 one-time fee
 - o Late & Provisional Ballot Board (LPBB) Presiding Judge - \$25.00 one-time fee
 - o Transportation of Equipment & Supplies - \$25.00 one-time fee per location (no mileage)
 - o Poll Worker Training - \$10.00 one-time fee per Poll Worker; only eligible with completion of 2 hour in-person training plus online training.

Each Early Voting and Consolidated Election Day polling location is proposed to have a total of three (3) Poll Workers by site, this total includes the respective Lead Clerk or Presiding Judge. The only exception is for the Hallsville VFD-ESD 5 Main Station where four (4) Poll Workers are proposed during Early Voting and on Election Day based on the City of Hallsville Mayor & Alderman At Large Election occurring as part of a Joint Agreement with Harrison County.

The proposed number of members for each respective Ballot Board is three (3).
