MASS MAIL OUT OF VOTER REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE RENEWALS

The Harrison County Elections Office will mail out new voter registration certificates every two years.

This occurs every odd year. The color of the cards changes every two years.

Your voter registration is automatically renewed every two years. You do not have to register again and again.

However, if you move without notifying the elections office, you may be placed on suspense. If our office receives mail returned by the USPS that isn't forwarded, then we don't know how to find you.

If you have committed a felony crime and have not completed your sentence, probation or parole or been otherwise pardoned or released therefrom, you temporarily lose your right to vote. That is only for felonies. Also if a person becomes completely mentally incapacitated.

If a person on the Suspense list has not updated their voter registration and has not voted, within two federal general elections, then their registration will be canceled. So get your information corrected and get out and vote!

Once you receive your voter registration card, please check it for accuracy. If changes need to be made, then you can make those on the card, sign it and mail it to the office at Post Office Box 8409, Marshall, TX 75671, or come in person to the physical address at 415 East Burleson, Marshall TX 75672. You could also write a letter. We cannot make changes over the phone. Need something in writing.
