



PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

Re: Mass Mail Out of Voter Registration Certificate Renewals

The Harrison County Elections Office mailed out voter registration certificate renewals in December of 2017. The next mailing will occur in December of 2019.

Voter registration certificates are automatically renewed every even-numbered year unless:

- The voter moves to another address; or
- The voter is convicted of a felony and has not completed the sentence, probation or parole or been otherwise pardoned or released from the resulting disability to vote.

Voters who have (1) not updated their residence address and their voter registration certificate is returned (the U.S. Postal Service will not forward) or (2) haven't satisfied the terms of a felony conviction will be placed in 'Suspense' status. Voters on the "Suspense List" are subject to having their voter registration canceled if their records are not updated within two federal general elections.

The current certificates are yellow and are valid from January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2019. They replace the blue voter registration certificates, which expired on December 31, 2017.

Voters are encouraged to check the information on their new certificates for accuracy and retain them for upcoming elections. Visit www.votetexas.gov for Voter Identification information.

Corrections, if necessary, may be made on the back of the card, signed and returned to the Harrison County Elections office – P.O. Box 8409, Marshall, Texas 75671.

Any person who has moved, had a name change or been previously registered in Harrison County and does not receive a new voter registration certificate by the end of December 2017 should contact the Harrison County Elections Office at 903-935-4822.
