**SEPTEMBER 23, 2011**

On September 9, 2011, President Obama issued a major disaster declaration for the State of Texas, triggering the release of Federal funds to help people recover from the wildfires, that began August 30, 2011, and continuing. **This disaster declaration has been amended as indicated below in bold.** Details of the disaster declaration and assistance program are as follows:

- Public Assistance (PA): (Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):
- PA-Designated Counties: Bastrop County for Public Assistance, including direct Federal assistance.
- Hazard Mitigation (HM): Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long-term risk to life and property from natural hazards.
- HM-Designated Counties: All counties in the State of Texas are eligible to apply for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.
- OTHER: Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.
