OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The Harrison County Commissioner's Court conducted public hearings on September 2, 2011 and September 6, 2011 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of Harrison County from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 1.31 percent.

The total tax revenue raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.3169 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$18,489,807.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.316900 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$18,581,599.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.316900 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$18,818,400.

The Harrison County Commissioner's Court is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 19, 2011 in the Commissioner's Courtroom, 2nd Floor, Harrison County Historic Courthouse, Marshall, Texas at 9:00 a.m.
