### NOTICE OF TAX YEAR 2016-17 PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR HARRISON COUNTY, TEXAS

A tax rate of \$0.3498 per \$100 valuation has been proposed for adoption by the governing body of Harrison County, Texas. This rate exceeds the lower of the effective or rollback tax rate, and state law requires that two public hearings be held by the governing body before adopting the proposed tax rate pursuant to LGC 140.010. Pursuant to LGC 140.010(e), the County proposes to use revenue attainable to the tax rate increase for the purpose of funding pay increase, making continued investment to a health plan trust, fund equipment and vehicle purchases without adding debt, upgrade software and associated equipment, repair buildings, add a deputy and dispatcher and save for future capital murder expense when necessary.

The effective tax rate is the total tax rate needed to raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Harrison County, Texas from the same properties in both the <u>2014-2015</u> tax year and the <u>2015-2016</u> tax year.

The rollback tax rate is the highest tax rate that Harrison County, Texas may adopt before voters are entitled to petition for an election to limit the rate that may be approved to the rollback rate.
