# “NOTICE OF 2017-18 TAX YEAR PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR HARRISON COUNTY

“A tax rate of \$0.3498 per \$100 valuation has been proposed for adoption by the governing body of HARRISON COUNTY. This rate exceeds the lower of the effective or rollback tax rate, and state law requires that two public hearings be held by the governing body before adopting the proposed tax rate. The governing body of Harrison County proposes to use revenue attributable to the tax rate increase for the purpose of to pay unfunded state mandates and basic county services.

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$0.3498 per \$100

PRECEDING YEAR'S TAX RATE \$0.3498 per \$100

EFFECTIVE TAX RATE \$0.339886 per \$100

ROLLBACK TAX RATE \$0.367944 per \$100

“The effective tax rate is the total tax rate needed to raise the same amount of property tax revenue for HARRISON COUNTY from the same properties in both the 2016-17 tax year and the 2017-18 tax year.

“The rollback tax rate is the highest tax rate that HARRISON COUNTY may adopt before voters are entitled to petition for an election to limit the rate that may be approved to the rollback rate.

“YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE ABOVE RATES CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

property tax amount =  $(\text{rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$
