

ORDER OF VOTE TO SET TAX RATE

“ Zephaniah Timmins move that property **tax rate** be increased by the **adoption** of a **tax rate** of \$0.354800 which is effectively a .65 percent increase in the **tax rate** for fiscal year 2020-2021” Seconded by William Hatfield

Voting In Favor: Chad Sims, County Judge, William Hatfield, Commissioner, Pct. 1, Zephaniah Timmins, Commissioner, Pct. 2, Phillip Mauldin, Commissioner, Pct. 3, Jay Ebarb, Commissioner, Pct. 4

Voting Against: NONE

(A) “THIS **TAX RATE** WILL RAISE MORE **TAXES** FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR’S **TAX RATE**,” and

(B) “THE **TAX RATE** WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY .66 PERCENT BY WHICH THE **TAX RATE** (EXCEEDS THE EFFECTIVE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS **RATE**) AND WILL RAISE **TAXES** FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000.00 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$0.25 .

THEREFORE, WE, THE COMMISSIONERS’ COURT OF HARRISON COUNTY DO HEREBY LEVY AND ADOPT THE TAX RATE ON \$100 VALUATION FOR HARRISON COUNTY FOR FY 2020-2021 TO BE \$0.354800.
